1. The Council met on six occasions during 2008, at St Andrew's Cathedral School in the city, preceded by a meal.

3. Before the Synod elections in October, the following valued members of Council announced their intention not to re-stand for election; Rev Dr Tim Foster, Mrs Jeanette Glass, Mr Allan Pidgeon. These last two have been members of the Council since its inception. Council was brought up to full strength with the election/appointment of the Rev Dave Rogers, the Rev Dominic Steele, Mr Ken Breakspear, Dr Ken Simpson and Mr Mark Wormell.

Developing Ministry Strategies

4. Council trialled a "Parish Growth Plan" with the bishop leading a small group of rectors. The intention is that a wider group of new rectors will trial this in 2009.

- 8. Council also affirmed the applications of South Sydney and Ashfield/Five Dock/Haberfield that the provisions of the Parishes Special Administration Ordinance 2004 apply and supported the creation of the parish of Ashfield/Five Dock/Haberfield.
- 9. Council adopted a risk management policy in 2009 under the amended Accounts, Audits and Annual Reports Ordinance 1995. A copy of this policy is included with the annual report provided to Synod under that Ordinance.
