The Church of England Homes Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1944.

No. 4, 1944.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Constitution of the Church of England Homes.

WHEREAS by The Church of England Homes Constitution Ordinance 1930 the Synod of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney approved the amalgamation of the Societies theretofore existing and known respectively as The Church of England Homes and The Church of England Committee for Homes and Hostels for Children and the constitution of the amalgamated Society known as The Church of England Homes (hereinafter called the Society) set forth in the Schedule to such Ordinance was thereby ratified and confirmed and by such Ordinance it was declared that the said Society should be thenceforth managed and conducted pursuant to the said Constitution. AND WHEREAS by Paragraph 24 of the said Constitution it is provided that the said Constitution shall not be altered amended or added to except as determined by the resolution of a duly convened Annual or Extraordinary General Meeting passed by a majority of not less than two-thirds of the members present at such Meeting and entitled to vote in respect thereof under the provisions of the said Constitution. AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the Constitution of the said Society should be' amended in manner hereinafter appearing. Now THEREFORE the Synod of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney hereby ordains declares directs and rules as follows:----

4. The Constitution of The Church of England Homes is hereby amended by the addition to the end of Paragraph 24 hereof of the following words: "and approved by a resolution of the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Church of England in the Diocese of Sydney."
