Cronulla Variation of Trusts Ordinance 2010

No 38, 2010

Long Title

An Ordinance to vary the trusts of certain personal property held by the wardens of St Andrew's Cronulla.

The Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

Preamble

A. The wardens of St Andrew's Cronulla are the trustees of certain personal property known as the St Andrew's Cronulla Organ Fund (the "Fund").

B. The Fund is held on trust for the purchase, installation and maintenance of a pipe or electric organ for St Andrew's Cronulla although there are no written trusts.

C. By reason of circumstances that have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Fund is held, it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts of the Fund be varied in the manner set out in this ordinance.

1. Name

This Ordinance is the Cronulla Variation of Trusts Ordinance 2010.

2. Declarations

By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Fund is held, it is inexpedient to carry out and observe those trusts and it is expedient that the trusts of the Fund be varied in the manner set out in clause 3.

3. New Trusts

The Fund, and all property received by the wardens from time to time as an addition to the Fund, is held on trust, in equal shares, for the purpose of -

- (a) maintaining or replacing an existing organ in St Andrew's, Cronulla, and
- (b) upgrading and maintaining the audio visual system in one or more churches of the Parish of Cronulla.
