## The Elections Ordinance 1934-1959 Amending Ordinance 1965

## No. 31, 1965.

AN ORDINANCE to amend The Elections Ordinance 1934-59.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend The Elections Ordinance 1934-1959 NOW the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains declares and rules as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Elections Ordinance 1934-1959 Amending Ordinance 1965."

- 2. (a) The Elections Ordinance 1934-1959 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
  - (b) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as "Elections Ordinance 1934-1965."

3. Clause 2 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the figure "(1)" at the commencement and by adding the following new sub-clause at the end:-

"(2) In the case of a retiring member of any committee council board or other body to which this ordinance applies if such member is eligible for re-election it shall be sufficient ground for the proposer or seconder to certify as aforesaid if the chairman or secretary of such committee council board or other body shall have certified that there is good reason to believe that such retiring member is willing to be nominated."
