

First Aid Training 2023 Provide First Aid - HLTAID011

The training will be provided by **Red Cross Training Services** (Registered Training Organisation No. 3605) delivering nationally recognised First Aid Training.

The Provide First Aid course is nationally accredited and will give you the skills and knowledge required to provide First Aid response, and life support and management of casualty(s) in a range of situations, including in the home, workplace or within the community, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

NB: it is a requirement that practical demonstration of CPR must be performed on the floor.

You will learn -

- Basic Life Support (DRSABCD)
- CPR and AED
- Shock Management
- Airway Management-Asthma, Choking, Severe Allergic Reaction, Hyperventilation
- Cardiac Emergencies
- Seizures and Convulsions
- Bleeding and Wound Care
- Burns and Scalds
- Extremes of Heat and Cold
- Musculoskeletal Injuries
- Poisons and Toxic Substances
- Bites and Stings
- Abdominal injuries

Option 1 - **Blended Online Format** – this is suitable for those seeking to gain their Certificate for the first time, or whose Certificate is more than 3 months out of date (an on-line training component to be completed prior to attending the practical course).

Option 2 – **Refresher** – This is for those needing to renew their current Certificate (just bring your current Certificate on the day).

Assessment on the day

- Theory 40 multiple choice questions, pass mark is 75%
- Practical Resuscitation skills, Casualty management skills

- A4 certificate
- Card 'certificate' (for your wallet or purse)

Option 3 – **CPR Refresher (Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation HLTAID009)** – this is suitable for those seeking to renew the CPR component of their First Aid certificate. Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) delivers the knowledge and skills necessary to maintain breathing and circulation in an adult, child or infant following cardiac arrest or other emergency.

Course inclusions (based on Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines)

- Legal and other requirements
- Basic Life Support (DRSABCD)
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) steps
- Demonstration and use of a defibrillator (AED)
- Debriefing and welfare

Fee
