The King's School Council Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1948.

No. 14, 1948.

AN ORDINANCE to amend "The King's School Council Constitution Ordinance 1922."

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal Clause 3 of "The King's School Council Constitution Ordinance, 1922" and make other provision for the constitution of a quorum of meetings of the said Council.

Now therefore the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney ordains declares directs and rules as follows:---

1. That Clause 3 of "The King's School Council Constitution Ordinance, 1922," be and the same is hereby repealed.

2. That a new clause be substituted in place of the said Clause 3 namely:-

"3. At meetings of the Council seven members of whom at least five shall be Governors shall form a quorum save that for the purpose of transacting such business as the Council at a meeting at which such a quorum is present may from time to time declare to be in the nature of routine business any seven members shall form a quorum. The Chairman of all meetings shall have both a deliberative and casting vote and in the absence of the Archbishop, his Commissary or the Administrator, the Chairman shall be a Governor."

3. The Ordinance may be cited as "The King's School Council Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1948." The King's School Council Constitution Amendment Ordinance 1948.
