The Synod Estimates Ordinance 1998 as amended by the Synod Estimates and Parochial Cost Recoveries (Alignment of Strategy) Ordinance 2008, the Synod Estimates Ordinance 1998 Amendment Ordinance 2011, the Synod Estimates and Parochial Cost Recoveries (Transition) Ordinance 2012 and the Synod Estimates Ordinance 1998 Amendment Ordinance 2015.

### Long Title

An Ordinance to provide for the preparation of Synod estimates.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney Ordains as follows.

#### 1. Name

This Ordinance is the Synod Estimates Ordinance 1998.

#### 2. Definition

In this Ordinance “financial year” means a period of 12 calendar months commencing on 1 January.

#### 3. Estimates to be Prepared for the Synod

(1) The Standing Committee must prepare for the second ordinary session of the 49<sup>th</sup> Synod a statement of funding principles and priorities and a proposed ordinance reflecting that statement which contains estimates for the following financial year of the matters specified in subclause (4).

(2) The Standing Committee must prepare for the third ordinary session of the 49<sup>th</sup> Synod a proposed ordinance reflecting the statement referred to in subclause (1) which contains estimates for the following two financial years of the matters specified in subclause (4).

(3) The Standing Committee must prepare for the first ordinary session of the 50<sup>th</sup> Synod and the first ordinary session of each Synod thereafter a statement of funding principles and priorities to guide the estimates referred to in subclause (4).

(3A) A statement of funding principles and priorities prepared for the first ordinary session of the 51<sup>st</sup> Synod and the first ordinary session of each Synod thereafter is to be accompanied by a motion moved by request of the Standing Committee by which the Synod may approve the Statement.

(4) The Standing Committee must prepare for the second ordinary session of the 50<sup>th</sup> Synod and the second ordinary session of each Synod thereafter a proposed ordinance which contains estimates for each of the following 3 financial years of –

- (a) the amount required for meeting the cost of sittings of the Synod, the maintenance of the diocesan offices and the expenses of such other diocesan activities and commitments as, in the opinion of the Standing Committee, should be supported;
- (b) the amount which, in the opinion of the Standing Committee, should be granted to organisations under the control of Synod or to other organisations; and
- (c) the amount available for distribution from endowments or other trusts for meeting the amounts referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) which, in the opinion of the Standing

Committee, may prudently be applied towards meeting the amounts referred to in paragraphs (a) and (b) in the relevant financial year.

(5) A proposed ordinance prepared under subclause (4) for consideration at the second ordinary session of the 50<sup>th</sup> Synod is to reflect the statement of funding principles and priorities prepared under subclause (3).

(6) A proposed ordinance prepared under subclause (4) for consideration at the second ordinary session of the 51<sup>st</sup> Synod and the second ordinary session of each Synod thereafter is, as far as practicable, to reflect –

- (a) the statement of funding principles and priorities approved by the Synod at the first ordinary session of that Synod, or
- (b) any other determination made by the Synod in relation to such Statement.

**5. Distribution of Ordinance and statement of funding principles and priorities**

The Standing Committee must distribute a copy of each proposed ordinance and statement of funding principles and priorities referred to in clause 3 to all members of the Synod not less than 14 days before the first day of the session at which the proposed ordinance or statement of funding principles and priorities is to be considered.
