Proposal for Culburra Beach to become a Provisional Parish

(A report from WARC.)

Initiation of Proposal

1. A proposal was made to the Archbishop by the Churchwardens of St John's Culburra Beach on 6 April 1993 in accordance with clause 4(1)(a) and (3) of the Parishes Ordinance 1979.

Details of Meeting

- 2. A meeting of the Wollongong Anglican Regional Council was held on 11 May 1993 to consider the proposal.
- 3. WARC certified that all procedural requirements under clause 4 of the Parishes Ordinance had been complied with and noted that no objections had been received or expressed.

Details of the Proposal

4. The following details were given with regard to church property in the proposed provisional parish -

- 5. The rectory is a 2 storey brick building which meets diocesan requirements. It was purchased in 1988 and was fully paid off in 1991.
- 6. In October 1992 St John's Church Culburra Beach was extended to include a hall and kitchen at a cost of \$46,803. A loan from the Finance and Loans Board has been reduced from \$25,000 to \$19,509 in the period from October 1992 to April 1993. This is the only debt in the proposed provisional parish.
