
*St. Mark's Avalon Beach Building Fund Variation of
Trust Ordinance 1961.*

No. 49, 1961.

AN ORDINANCE to vary the trusts upon which certain moneys and/or the investments known as St. Mark's Church of England Avalon Beach Building Fund are held.

WHEREAS certain moneys totalling Two thousand five hundred and seventy pounds sixteen shillings and two pence (£2,570:16:2) have been subscribed and paid to the Churchwardens of St. Mark's Church of England Avalon Beach in the Parish of Pittwater for the purpose of erecting a new church at Avalon Beach AND WHEREAS part of such funds namely Two thousand three hundred and thirty pounds (£2,330.) have been invested in Commonwealth Special Bonds Series "B" AND WHEREAS the said moneys and investments are church trust property held for the sole benefit of the Parish of Pittwater AND WHEREAS it is expedient to apply such funds towards the erection of a new Parish Hall at Avalon Beach in lieu of the proposed new church NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the said Synod HEREBY ORDAINS AND DIRECTS as follows:-

1. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the sum of Two thousand five hundred and seventy pounds sixteen shillings and two pence (£2,570:16:2) or the investments representing the same (hereinafter called the said Funds) are held by the Churchwardens of St. Mark's Church of England Avalon Beach it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that such trusts be varied as hereinafter set out.

2. The said funds shall be held by the said Churchwardens upon trust to meet in part the cost of erection of a new Parish Hall at Avalon Beach in connection with the Church of St. Mark's Avalon Beach in the Parish of Pittwater.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Mark's Avalon Beach Building Fund Variation of Trust Ordinance 1961."
