## NO. 46 ,1987

AN ORDINANCE to authorise the sale of certain property at Belfield and to provide for the disposal of the proceeds thereof.

## WHEREAS

- A. Anglican Church Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (formerly known as Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (and hereinafter called the "Corporate Trustee") is the registered proprietor of the land and property described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter called "the Property").
- B. The Property is church trust property held by the Corporate Trustee upon trust to permit the same to be used for a church, parsonage or parish hall or partly for one or partly for another or others of such purposes in connection with the Church of England in Australia in the Provisional Parish of Belfield or any parish into which may subsequently be formed.
- C. There is constructed upon the Property a church, a parish hall and a minister's residence.
- D. On 29 March 1987 a duly convened Vestry Meeting of the Parish (hereinafter called "the last Vestry Meeting") resolved to recommend the closure of the church on the Property for church services as from 30 April 1987 and the amalgamation of various parts of the Provisional Parish with adjoining Parishes of Enfield and Campsie, the sale of the Property and the disposal of the sale proceeds.
- E. The church situated on the Property was de-licensed for church purposes by the Archbishop as from 30 April 1987 an by reason of such circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the Property is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent that

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the same are hereby varied and it is expedient that the Property be sold.

NOW the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and place of the Synod HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES as follows.

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- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "St Paul's Belfield Sale Ordinance 1987".
- 2. By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts on which the Property is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same and it is expedient that the Property be sold.
- 3. The Corporate Trustee is hereby empowered to sell the Property within three (3) years after the date of assent to this Ordinance and thereafter only with the consent of the Standing Committee, by public auction or private contract in one or more lots and for such price or prices and upon and subject to such terms and conditions as the Corporate Trustee may determine, freed from the trusts upon which the Property is now held.
- 4. The proceeds from the sale of the Property shall be applied in meeting all costs of and incidental to this Ordinance and to the sale of the Property including any incidental sub-division costs and then in or towards the following.
  - (a) In repayment of any moneys owing by the said Provisional Parish to the Sydney Church of England Finance and Loans Board.
  - (b) / In discharge of any liabilities incurred by the Churchwardens for the time being of the said church in the said Provisional Parish in relation to the repair and maintenance of the buildings and fixtures on the Property and that there also be paid to the said Churchwardens such sum as is required to reimburse or pay them for moneys paid in respect of any such repairs and maintenance.

    Any unpaid omounts in respect of making the property Safe or Saleable.

Meeting, in paying the Reverend John Wyndham, the former Minster of the said Provisional Parish prior to the said de-licensing of the church on the Property, the following sums:-

(i) a sum equivalent to the amount to which the Reverend John Wyndam would be entitled for annual leave or holiday pay in respect of a period of eight (8) weeks immediately prior to such closure which said sum is calculated at \$4,363.40;

(ii) all or any arrears of stipend to which he is entitled and which remain unpaid to him the total sum of which is calculated at \$8,215; and

(iii) the sum of \$10,000 in consideration for services rendered by him while Minister of the Provisional Parish in circumstances where he was paid a stipend which was substantially less than a stipend which in view of the former Parish Council of the Provisional Parish should have

- / (f) In distributing the residue of the aforementioned proceeds after payment or appropriation as aforesaid in accordance with paragraphs (a) to (e) as follows:-
  - (i) as to a thirty-five per centum (35%) share thereof such sum shall be invested by the Corporate Trustee and that ten per centum (10%) of the income therefrom/be capitalised and the balance of the income be paid or applied in or towards the payment of stipends, salaries or. other payments in connection with the employment of a Youth Worker or Youth Workers or other lay person or persons employed by the Marrickville Area Deanery Committee for the purpose of pastoral ministry within the Marrickville Area Deanery Area and any income not so paid or applied shall be capitalised provided however that the whole or any part or parts of any such money so capitalised may be used in or towards such purposes as aforesaid in accordance with this sub-paragraph at the discretion of the said committee from time to time if it resolves that the use of such moneys is necessary or desirable in the best interests of the Marrickville Area /

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- therein;
- (ii) as to an eighteen per centum (18%) share thereof such sum shall be paid to the Archbishop's Vision for Growth Appeal;
- (iii) as to a thirty-five per centum (35%) share such sum shall be paid to the Parish of Campsie for such purposes in the said parish or outside the said parish as the Parish Council thereof from time to time may by resolution determine; and
- (iv) as to a twelve per centum (12%) share such sum shall be paid to the Parish of Enfield for such purposes in the said Parish or outside the said Parish as the Parish Council thereof from time to time may by resolution determine.

## SCHEDULE

All that parcel of land in the Municipality of Canterbury Parish of St George and County of Cumberland containing 2 roods 30 perches or thereabouts being Lots 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Section G in Deposited Plan No 8832 and comprising the whole of the land in Certificate of Title Volume 2806 Folio 38.
