St. Philip's Rectorship of 1924.

AN ORDINANCE to provide for the appointment of future Rectors of the Parish of St. Philip, Sydney, and to amend the Presentation Ordinance of 1895 and any Ordinance amending the same.

The Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales and by the "Church of England Trust Property Act 1917" (No. 21) and of all other powers thereunto enabling it ordains declares determines directs and rules as follows:--

1. That notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Presentation Ordinance of 1895 or any Ordinance amending or taking the place of the same whenever a vacancy shall occur in the office of Rector of the Parish of St. Philip Sydney it shall be competent if so determined by the Standing Committee and the Parochial Nominators for the time being of the said Parish by a majority of the votes of the said Standing Committee and Parochial Nominators taken collectively for the Archbishop to appoint a Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Sydney as Rector of the said Parish of St. Philip within six months of the date when such vacancy shall occur. If no appointment shall be made within the time specified the vacancy shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of the Presentation Ordinance of 1895 or any Ordinance amending or taking the place of the same.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Philip's Rectorship Ordinance of 1924,"
