ST. STEPHEN'S PENRITH CEMETERY ORDINANCE 1979

No. 17. 1979

AN ORDINANCE to vary the trusts on which certain land in the City of Penrith is held and to provide for the care management and control of certain adjoining land.

## WHEREAS:

<u>A.</u> Church of England Property Trust Diocese of Sydney (hereinafter called the "Corporate Trustee") is the registered proprietor of the land described in the First Schedule hereto (which land is hereinafter called "the said land") and the said land is church trust property within the meaning of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as amended.

<u>B.</u> By Certificate of Consecration dated 16th July 1839 the building known as St. Stephen's Church, erected on part of the said land, was consecrated and by a further Certificate of Consecration dated 16th July 1839 the said land was also consecrated "as the Church Yard, Cemetery or Burying Place for the Dead Bodies of the Christian Residents and Inhabitants of Penrith".

<u>C.</u> The Cemetery on the part of the said land which is described in the Third Schedule hereto contains several historic graves and headstones and it is beyond the resources of the minister and churchwardens of the said church to maintain the same and the Council of the City of Penrith has expressed willingness to assume responsibility for the care control and management of the said part of the said land.

D. It is expedient that a further provision be made for the care control and management of the land described in the Third Schedule hereto.

<u>E.</u> By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the trusts upon which the land described in the Second Schedule hereto is held it is expedient to vary the same to the extent hereinafter setforth.

NOW THE STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE SYNOD OF THE DIOCESE OF SYDNEY in the name and the place of the said Synod <u>HEREBY ORDAINS DECLARES DIRECTS AND RULES</u> as follows:-1. (1) By reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation

of the trusts upon which the land described in the Second Schedule is held it is inexpedient to carry out and observe the same to the extent to which such trusts are hereby varied.

(2) The land described in the Second Schedule hereto is to be held upon trust for a:-

(a) church;

(b) residence for a minister, assistant to the minister or person employed by the churchwardens;

(c) hall or halls;

(d) school or other place of assembly;

or partly for one or another of those purposes in connection with the Church of England in Australia within the Diocese of Sydney for the sole benefit of the parish or other ecclesiastical district of St. Stephen at Penrith or any parish or ecclesiastical district into which it may subsequently be formed or form a part.

2. (1) The Corporate Trustee is hereby authorised and empowered to enter into an agreement with the Council of the City of Penrith under which the said Council shall assume responsibility for the care control and management of the land described in the Third Schedule hereto and the cemetery thereon. The said agreement shall contain such indemnities and other clauses as may seem fit to the Corporate Trustee.

(2) During the term of any such agreement the provisions of Section 29 of the Sydney Church Ordinance 1912 as amended shall be suspended as regards the land described in the Third Schedule hereto.

<u>3.</u> The Corporate Trustee is hereby authorised and empowered to enter into an agreement with the Council of the City of Penrith pursuant to paragraph (b) of Section 452E(4) of the Local Government Act 1919 to facilitate the publication of a notification in the Grazette pursuant to Section 452E(1) of the said Act. And The said ägreement shall contain such clauses as may seem fit to the Corporate Trustee.

This Ordinance may be cited as "St. Stephen's Penrith Cemetery Ordinance 1979".

## FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land situate and being on the south side of the High Road from Sydney to Bathurst in Penrith aforesaid containing one acre more or less whereon has been erected and built the Church of St Stephen the Martyr bounded on the north by a line west along the road 165 feet in length commencing at the north west corner of land theretofore belonging to John Tindale and formerly in the occupation of Charles Sims on the west by a line south 282 feet 6 inches thence on the north again by a west line 49 feet, on the west again by a line south 323 feet 7 inches thence on the south by a line east 154 feet and thence on the east by a line north 658 feet 6 inces to the Western Road.
