AN ORDINANCE for the variation of the trusts of certain moneys held for the benefit of the Parish of St. Stephen the Martyr, Penrith.

WHEREAS:-

- (a) In or about the year 1938 in connection with the centenary of the Church of the Parish of St. Stephen the Martyr, Penrith, a Fund (hereinafter called the said Fund) was raised for the purpose of adding to the existing Church a Chancel Organ Chamber and Vestry but owing to the outbreak of war and building difficulties nothing was done in that respect and the said Fund at present amounts to £567.
- (b) The said Church requires extensive repairs and renovations.

Now the Standing Committee of the Synod of the Diocese of Sydney in the name and in the place of the said Synod ordains and declares as follows—

- 1. By reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of the trusts of the said Fund it has become impossible or inexpedient to carry out such trusts to the extent to which they are hereby varied.
- 2. The said Fund shall be paid to the said Churchwardens and applied by them in carrying out repairs and renovations to the Church of St. Stephen the Martyr, Penrith.
- 3. The receipt of the said Churchwardens shall be a sufficient discharge for any moneys paid to them in pursuance of this Ordinance.
- 4. This Ordinance may be called the "St. Stephen's Penrith Centenary Fund (Variation of Trusts) Ordinance 1951."
