## **TEMOC Grants for 2024 Information For Applicants**

The Diocese has supported ministry among tertiary students over many years, most recently through the Tertiary Education Ministry Oversight Committee (TEMOC). There is a short video (made in 2015) outlining this work that can be <u>seen here</u>.

TEMOC is now inviting applications for grants for new and existing projects across the Tertiary Education sector (including both University and TAFE/ VET oriented ministries) for 2024.

Details of the TEMOC Funding Model and allocation policies may be found here (particularly from section 8 onward) – we strongly encourage you to read through this if you are considering applying for a grant.

Please note that funding for any grant in the first year of a new project will be not more than 50% of the total cost of the project, and indeed, given our limited resources (in previous years this has been around \$100,000 distributed among 13 projects), may be considerably less. Grants for continuation of existing 2022 and 2023 projects will be on a reducing scale over 2-3 years.

Applications for continuing or new projects should be submitted online using the TEMOC Grant 2023 Preliminary Application form by no later than Tuesday September 3, 2023. Applications received after this date may not be considered by the committee. Please use separate applications if you are applying for more than one grant – with the exception that if you are applying for grants for a group of 'trainees', they can be combined together on one application.

Following consideration of Preliminary Applications, TEMOC may request further information from shortlisted applicants. Successful applicants will be notified once funding is finalised. Successful applicants will be required to provide a report on the project and outcomes by May 2025.
